For the third time since they arrived at Ouwehand Zoo, the Nilgai Antelopes have bred: two calves again, both females.

ROTTERDAM - HOLLAND

Two highly interesting births took place at the Blijdorp Zoo: two Two-toed Sloths, of two different mothers, and twin Coucangs (Nycticebus coucang) were born. All four babier are doing well.

Among other recent births and hatchings are 3 Yaks, 1 Mouflon, 1 Puma, 2 Père David's Deer, a Chimpanzee, 1 Kudu, 1 Banteng, 1 Black Panther, a Caracal and 3 Black Swans.

Newcomers include: 2 Siamangs, 1 Galago, 4 Mongooses, 2 Squirrel Monkeys, 3 Lorikeets, 2 Brush-tailed Porcupines, a Hornbill, 2 Wattled Cranes and 3 Anteaters.

SAN DIEGO - CALIFORNIA - USA

Total attendance for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970, reached 3,129,144 persons.

The Sanctuary for the Koala colony has been enhanced by the planting of a Lemon-scented Eucalyptus (Eucalyptus citriodora), on June 8, 1970.

Two baby female Asiatic Elephants arrived in the Children's Zoo early in July. Upon arrival the babies were just over three feet high.
