

A three-year-old rhino calf was recently a "guest" at the Alipore Zoological Gardens, Calcutta, on its way from its ancestral home in the forests of Assam to America. Dr. Mann, of the Washington Zoological Society, has been trying for two years to secure an Indian rhinoceros with one horn. This year the Conservator of Forests in Assam captured a rhino calf which has been insured and kept in the Calcutta Zoo at the request of the Consul-General for America, pending transshipment.
