Glenogle's Menagerie.

On the arrival, at Rangoon, of the steamer Glenogle from the Straits on the 7th inst., at the latter Street Wharf she was boarded by Mr. Lim Chin Tsong and Mr. See, Curator of the Zoo at the Victoria Memorial Park, who took charge of a number of fine animals that had been purchased by the directors of the Zoo through Mr. Chin Tsong in Borneo. The animal included a two-horned rhinoceros about four and half feet in height; two full grown ouragoutangs, male and female; two leopard cubs; one black gibbon; two musk deer, eighteen inches in height. All but one of the animals, one of the musk deer, were in fine condition. This deer, however, appeared to have been badly hurt on the voyage so Mr. Chin Tsong took it with the other one for treatment. The other animals were loaded on one of Messrs. D. Bern and Co's motor lorries and taken to the Zoo.
