George III Gift, 1823.1. C. 93 (authority?). M.B. Note forms of legend which are quite unusual on 'Aes' and absence of S·C. on *rev.*

2. C. 162 (Paris). M.B. See note on 1.

3. C. 277 (Paris), 'struck in Samaria'. M.B. Note absence of S·C. on *rev.*: C.'s comment may be near the truth.
