- **Regional Participatory Biodiversity Conservation Networking Seminar Held**  
A regional biodiversity conservation-networking seminar was organized by FONAREM in Kathmandu on 10-11 February 2001. Financial support for the networking seminar was provided by NORAD through the NORAGRIC. A total of 48 participants attended the seminar representing Nepal, India, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka and Norway.

State **Mr. Santosh Rayamajhi**, President of FONAREM chaired the seminar, **H. E. Ingrid Olfstad**, Norwegian Ambassador to Nepal was the Chief Guest, Secretary of Forest **Mr. Rabi Bahadur Bista** was the keynote speaker and present among others were the Natural Resource Managers, Scientists, Researchers, etc.

- **Rhino Translocation**

Department of National Parks and Wildlife Conservation (DNPWC) with collaboration with King Mahendra Trust for Nature Conservation (KMTNC) and World Wildlife Fund (WWF) – Nepal Programme have translocated 5 more rhinoceros to Royal Bardia National Park (RBNP) from Royal Chitwan National Park (RCNP) on March 2001. The main objective of this translocation is to strengthen the second viable population in RBNP. FONAREM members were involved in this project. A total of 63 numbers of rhinos have been translocated so far from RCNP to RBNP in an effort to build an alternate viable population of this endangered species. In addition, 4 rhinos have been translocated to Royal Suklaphanta Wildlife Reserve (RSWR) next to RBNP. FONAREM advisor *Dr. Shant Raj Gyawali*, and executive member *Mr. Narendra Pradhan* are the key professionals involved in the successful translocation initiatives.

- **GEF's Overall Performance Study**

The Global Environment Facility (GEF) is conducting its second overall performance study (OPS2) to obtain regional, country and project specific information as a feedback for its second general assembly being held in Beijing in October 2002. The study is focussed on GEF focal area of biodiversity, climate change, international waters and ozone depletion together with the cross cutting issues of land degradation. An eight-member independent study team headed by *Mr. Leif Christofersen* of NORAGRIC is conducting this global study. FONAREM president *Mr. S. Rayamajhi* has been appointed as local consultant to support the study team in Nepal during April-May 2001. The team will study the completed and ongoing Biodiversity Conservation Projects in Nepal.
