EXHIBITIONS AND NOTICES.

The Secretary read the following Report on the Additions to the Society's Menagerie during the months of June, July, August, and September 1933, :—

JUNE.

The registered additions to the Society's Menagerie in London (Mammals, Birds, and Reptiles) during the month of June were 329 in number. Of these 107 were acquired by presentation, 147 were purchased, 20 were deposited, 12 were received in exchange, and 43 were born in the Menagerie.

The following may be specially mentioned:-

1 Brazilian Tapir (Tapirus terrestris), born in the Menagerie on June 2nd.

1 Harnessed Antelope (Tragelaphus scriptus), 1 Wart-Hog (Phacochærus cethiopicus), 2 Crested Porcupines (Hystrix cristata), 1 Giant Rat (Cricetomys gambianus), 1 Pale Fox (Vulpes pallida), 1 Ashy Jackal (Canis adustus), 2 Goliath Herons (Ardea goliath), and 1 Crowned Crane (Balearica pavonina), all from Gambia, presented by Eric C. Johnson, Esq., C.M.Z.S., on June 6th.

2 Chinkara (Gazella bennettii), from India, presented by Major C. Davenport,

R.A.V.C., and Major L. H. Dorling, R.A., on June 8th.

2 Prince Rudolf's Birds-of-Paradise (*Paradisornis rudolfi*), 1 Superb Bird-of-Paradise (*Lophorhina superba*), and 2 Stella Lories (*Charmosyna stellæ*), all from the Kratke Mountains, British New Guinea, purchased on June 30th.

JULY.

The registered additions to the Society's Menagerie in London (Mammals, Birds, and Reptiles) during the month of July were 245 in number. Of these 115 were acquired by presentation, 43 were purchased, 6 were deposited, 51 were received in exchange, and 30 were born in the Menagerie.
