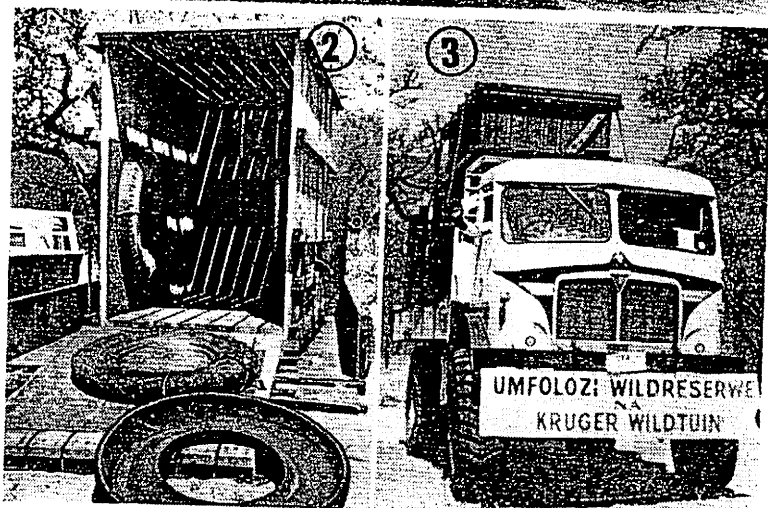


Square-lipped Rhinos' 370-mile Trip

Two young bulls and two cows were transported from the Umfolozi Game Reserve in Natal to the Kruger National Park, Transvaal, on 12/13 October in 26 hours.
