### WHITE RHINOS IN ROTTERDAM ZOO

The Royal Blijdorp Zoo again exhibits a pair of Rhinos: on 9th July 1963, a couple of young White Rhinos arrived. They came from the Umfolozi National Park in Natal, South Africa. Blijdorp Zoo is the third European Zoo to receive a couple of these rare Rhinos from Umfolozi.

### MANCHURIAN CRANE HATCHED

For the second time in the Frankfurt-am-Main Zoo, Germany, the Manchurian Cranes (*Crus japonensis*) have hatched and reared chicks.

After an incubation period of 30 days, both chicks came out of the eggs.

### PACHYDERMS PROTECTED

A recent decree by the government of the Congo Republic has prohibited the killing of Hippos throughout the country. It has also prohibited the killing of Elephants in certain districts including the environs of Brazzaville, the capital.

The boundaries of the Lefini Game Reserve have also been extended at the urgent request of the Chief Warden.
