San Diego - Cal. - U.S.A.

On February 28, "Jaypuri", a female Indian Rhinoceros, arrived at the San Diego Zoo as a mate for "Lasai" a two and one-half year old male that was born in the Basel Zoo. Jaypuri was born in an Assam zoo on July 10, 1963.

San Diego's first pair of Aardwolves arrived on March 4, from Southwest Africa. This seldom seen species is exhibited in only one other American 200, Philadelphia.

Also arrived on March 4, were five Gentoo and one Rockhopper Penguins. This raises San Diego's penguin collection to seven species.

Five Lucon parrots, Tanygnathus luconensis, arrived at the San Diego Zoo on 8 March 1965, from the Philippine Islands. This latest acquisition boosts San Diego's parrot collection to 102 species.
