
The King's Indian Animals.—According to the Indian papers of Jan. 25 the animals presented to the King by the Nepal Durbar were at that date on view in the Calcutta Zoological Gardens before being shipped to London. The young elephant, the young rhinoceros, the two snow leopards, the shou or Sikhim stag, the musk deer, the yak, goral, bharal, tahr, unicorn sheep, and the Himalayan pheasants are stated to have reached Calcutta in excellent condition. The whole collection includes about 100 specimens.
