The Rarest Rhino .- It is mentioned in the Annual Administration Report of the State of Perak, in the Federated Malay States, that a Javan rhinoceros (B. sondaicus) which was tracked down and observed in the Teluk Anson district of Perak in 1930, was the only known surviving specimen of that rare species in the State. Reports have been received, however, it is added, of the existence of another specimen in the vicinity of the Sungei Erong, Batang Padang district.
