*Boston, September 5.—Heavy importations.*—The ship *Bashaw*, which arrived from Batavia yesterday, has brought 7746 bags of coffee, 1254 do. pepper, 1249 slabs of Banca tin, besides a variety of other articles, including 2207 buffalo hides.

The ship *Dover*, from Calcutta, which arrived here yesterday afternoon, has on board 2900 bags of saltpetre, and 282 cases of indigo—also an elephant of heavy mould. A rhinoceros died on the passage.
