Josef Vágner (1928-2000) Czech forester, zoologist, world traveler, writer, long-term director of the Zoo in Dvůr Králové nad Labem, and founder of the local safari (today Safari Park Dvůr Králové). He studied at the Faculty of Forestry and Wood Sciences of the Czech University of Life Sciences in Prague. After he graduated, he studied tropical forestry and veterinary medicine. He was one of the first in the world to promote large panoramic enclosures and keeping animals in groups and in conditions as close to their natural habitat as possible. Between 1968 and 1976, he conducted several expeditions to Africa, and brought back thousands of animals for the zoo in Dvůr Králové as well as other European zoos. Thus, a unique collection of African ungulates was created in Dvůr Králové. The size and success of Vágner's transports has never been surpassed. Many of the descendants of the original animals have returned to Africa in order to increase the depleted populations. During his first expeditions to Africa, Josef Vágner's close collaborator was his wife, **Zdenka Vágnerová** (1929-2006).

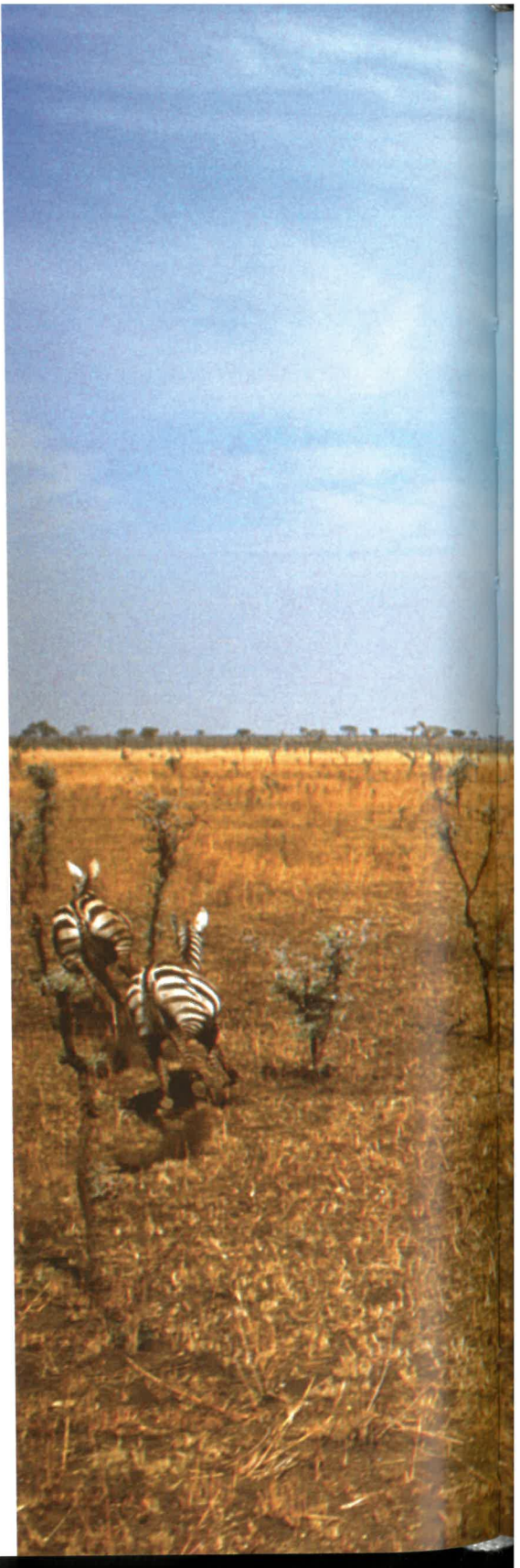
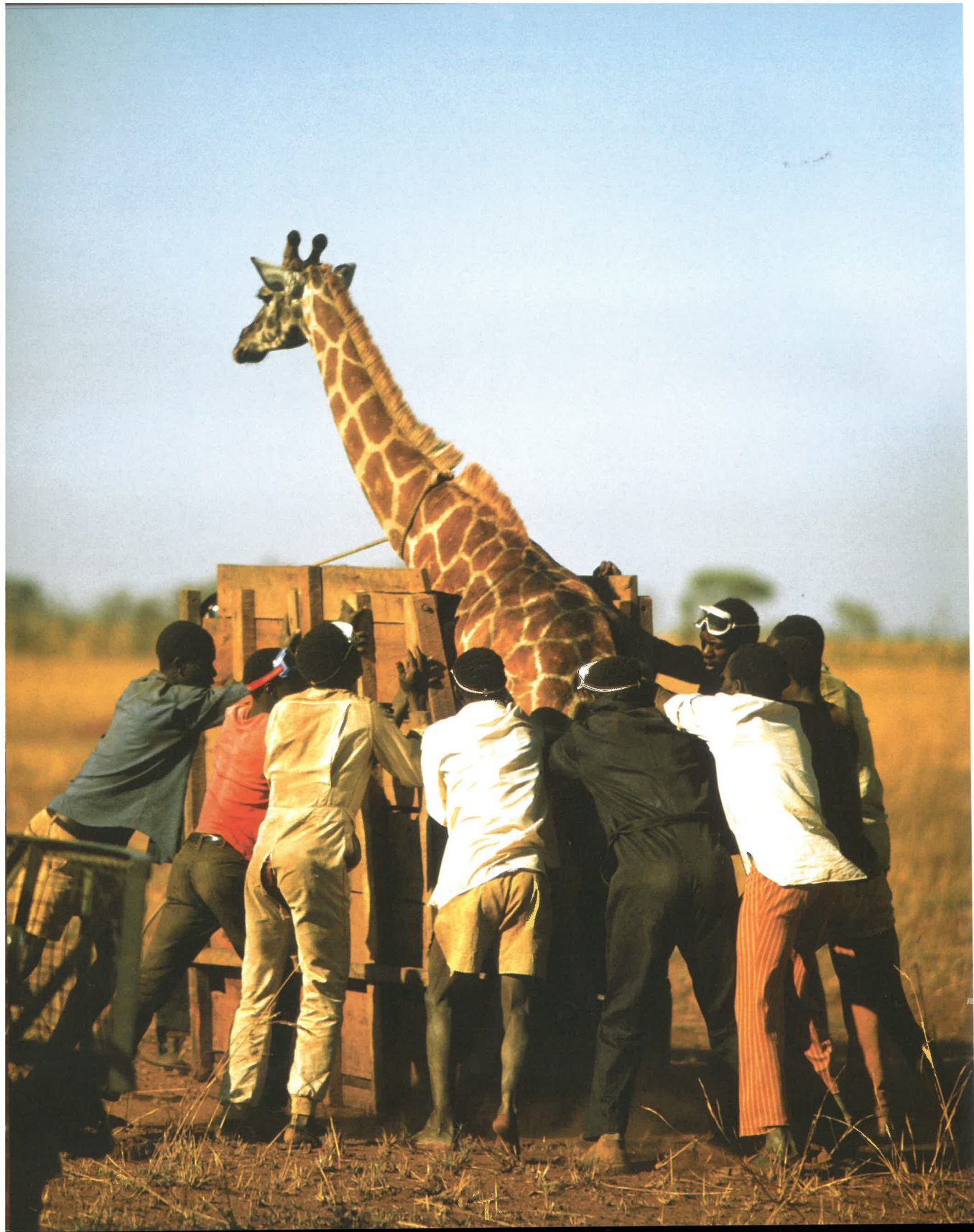

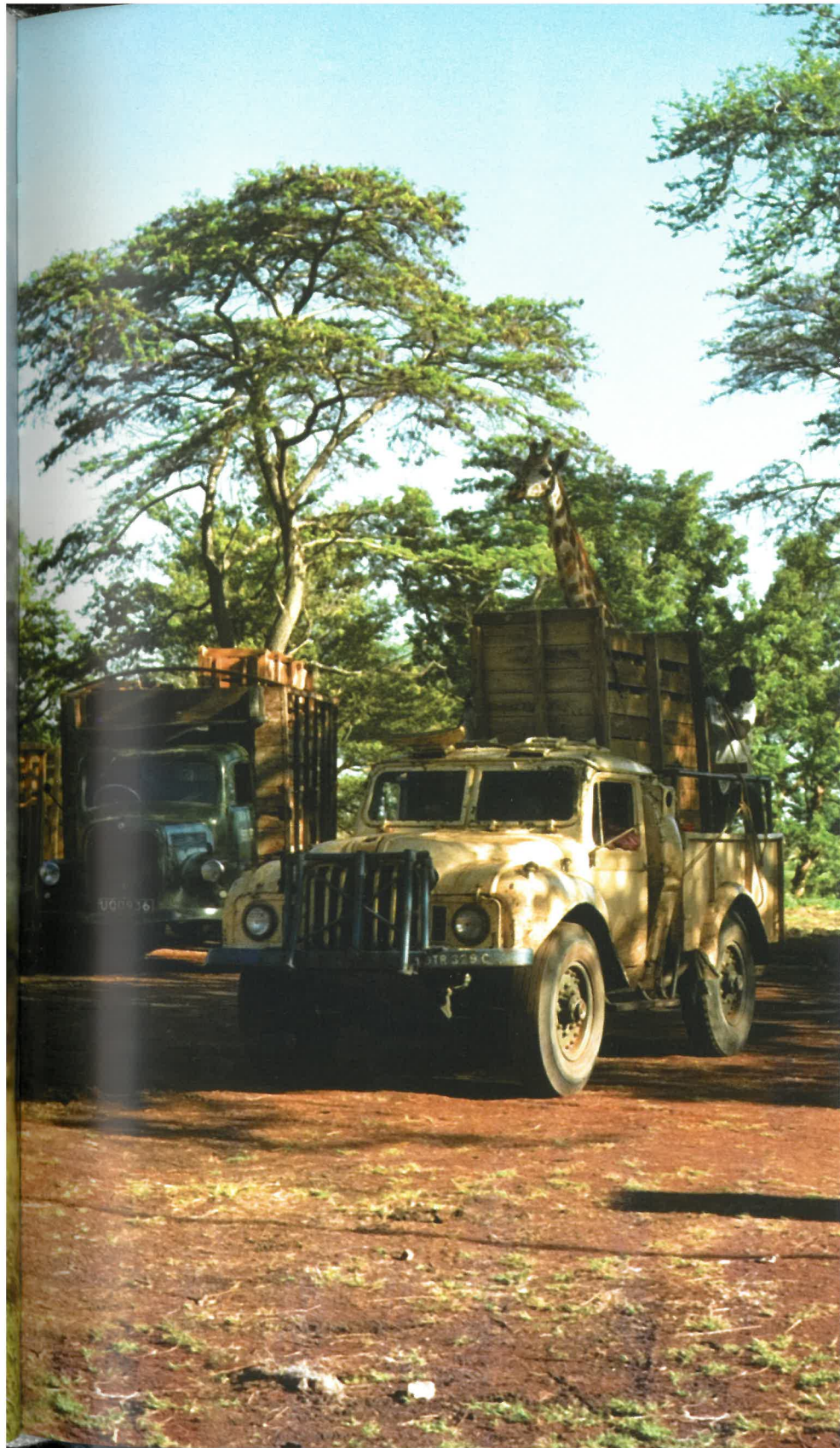

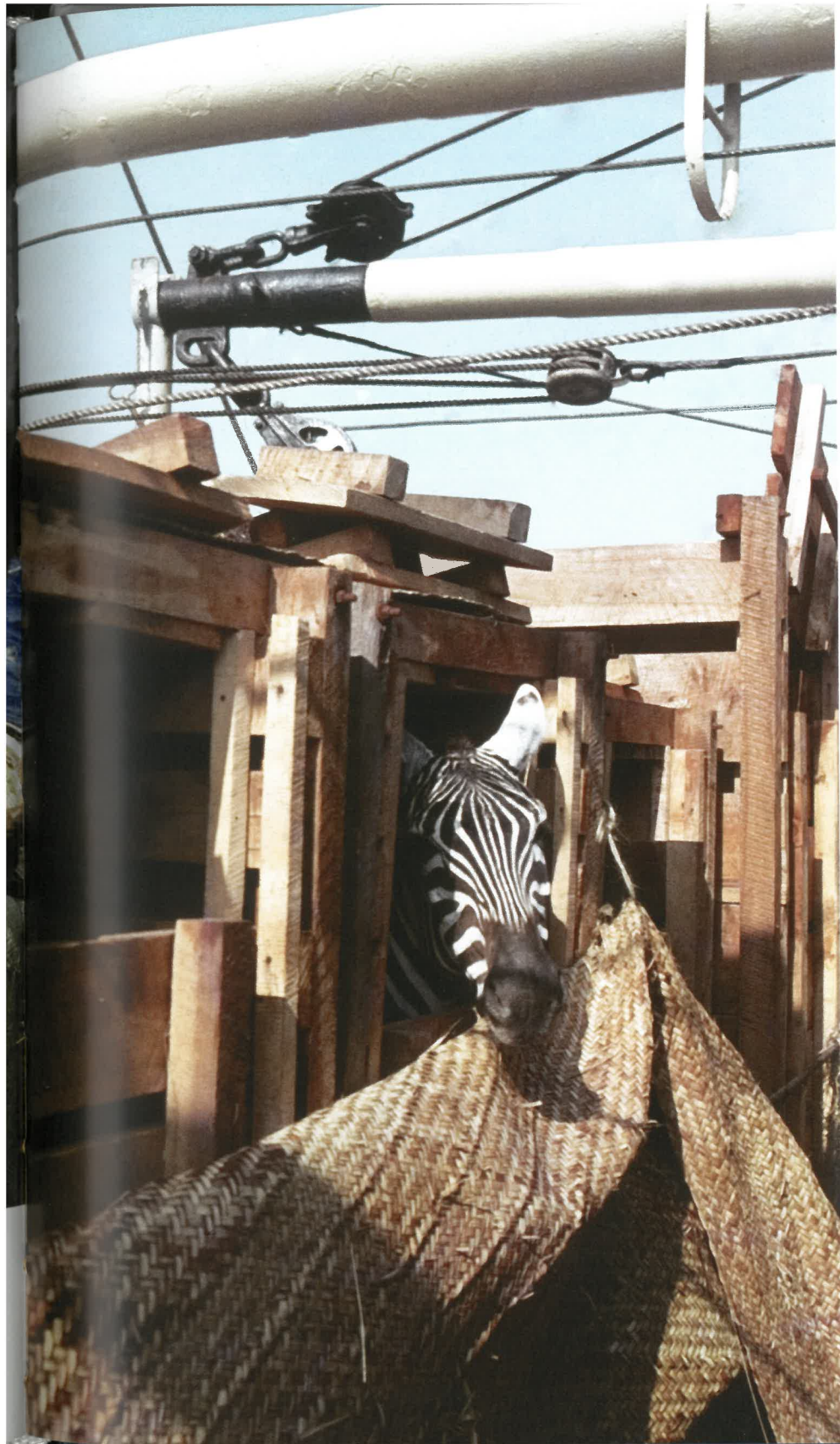
