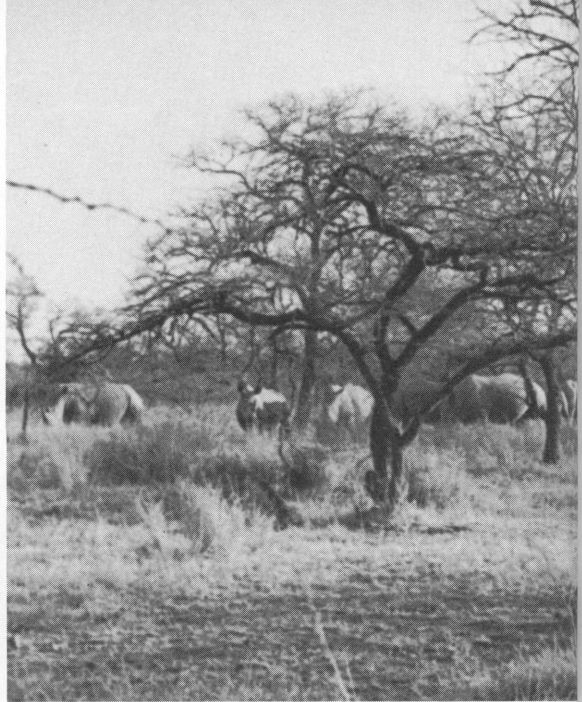


Two likely candidates for capture, grazing in the savanna.
