The following is a brief detail of a few of their Acrobatic Tricks and Performances, gone through by them at the command of their keeper, viz.:—They will first open the gate of their Apartment, then follow him to the centre of the Arena, lie or kneel down, and rise at the word of command, then stand erect on their two hind legs, with their fore feet on the shoulders of their keeper. They next mount the top of a pedestal, 3 feet high and about 18 inches in diameter, not sufficiently large to hold all their feet at one time, only by them being part over the sides of the pedestal. In this elevated position they will balance themselves on either one, two, three, or four legs, reversing them in as many various ways and attitudes, and will also turn themselves round on the top of the same small space at a rate of twelve or fourteen miles per hour, and to conclude, they will balance themselves on the crown of their heads, with perfect ease, thus showing off their perfect training and most extraordinary performances.

This singular and extraordinary quadruped was taken on the Plains of Abyssinia by a party of Native Hunting Excursionists, and brought 2000 miles across the deserts of Arabia to Alexandria, by Monsieur RINGLET and his attendants, and embarked in one of the great Liverpool steamers to that town, where it was landed in the month of October last, and purchased by the present Proprietor for the sum of £1000.
