The Amrita Bazar Patrika says he was previously a Maharajah **▼** Bahadoor, "the title having been enjoyed by the family before the advent of the English or perhaps that of the Mussulmans." The Viceroy has conferred the title of Maharajah upon Rajah Komul Krishna Deb; that of Rajah upon Rai Surjakant Θ Acharjee Bahadur, of Mooktagacha, Baboo Kristenden Roy, of Bolihar, and Baboo Sourindro Mohun Tagore, C.I.E.; and that of Maharajah Bahadoor upon Rajah Nripendro Naram of Cooch Behar. The latter title has been conferred "in recognition of the high rank and dignity of the holder." Mr. C. A. Daniell and Mr. King have been appointed Judges of Mainpure and Saharanpore.
