



NATIONAL PARKS BOARD

KEY OBJECTIVE STATEMENT

The key objective of the National Parks Board of Bophuthatswana is to develop and administer a profitable, scientifically-orientated land-use agency with a specific responsibility to ensure appropriate ecological management of renewable, wild natural resources, including the Parks and Wildlife Estate, and the servicing of the resource outside the Estate. The organization will protect landscapes of special quality; protect and apply appropriate ecological management to representative samples of natural ecosystems; protect and apply appropriate ecological management to indigenous species which are endangered, vulnerable, threatened or rare in southern Africa; ecologically manage and service the indigenous wild flora and fauna of Bophuthatswana, generally; and establish and ecologically manage, as part of the Parks and Wildlife Estate, natural and semi-natural areas for a wide range of outdoor recreational pursuits:

- i) for the benefit, enjoyment and cultural inspiration of the people of Bophuthatswana and their foreign visitors throughout the Republic of Bophuthatswana;
- ii) generally, for the long-term survival of man everywhere; and
- iii) to satisfy the identified needs of local and foreign clients who are prepared to pay a premium price for certain renewable wild natural resources and/or specific recreational facilities which can be made available by the Board on a controlled basis.


