RHINO BIRTH FIRST AT LINCOLN PARK ZOO

Lincoln Park Zoological Gardens, Chicago, Illinois announced the birth of the first black rhino in its 121-year history on 21 May. The male baby is a second-generation captive birth and the offspring of two zoo-born rhinos. The father was born at the San Francisco Zoological Gardens in 1981 and arrived in January 1982; the mother was born at the Cincinnati Zoo & Botanical Garden in September 1982 and arrived in June 1984. The youngster is the first offspring for both parents.
