### COLOBUS MONKEY BORN

In 1961 the West Berlin Zoo had imported one male and three female White-tailed Guereza Monkeys (*Colobus guereza cандatus*) from Kenya. After a premature birth in 1962 a young one was born on June 19th, 1963 but being not accepted by its mother it could not be raised by hand and died five days later. On May 12th, 1964, there was another premature birth and on July 14th a stillbirth. At last on August 29th a healthy snowy white young Guereza was born and accepted by its mother. Now aged 7 weeks it is thriving well and its coat is already turning darker. It is interesting to see that the young one is often taken away from the mother by the male and the two other females. We hope sincerely that it will be raised successfully.

### BLACK RHINO BORN
