It is illegal to take the horn and kill the animal, but people still disobey.


However, the animal needs their horn in order to survive.

There are five species of rhinoceros. Rhinos live in southern Asia and sub-Saharan Africa.

- Black rhino, *Diceros bicornis*
- White rhino, *Ceratotherium simum*
- Greater one-horned (Indian) rhino, *Rhinoceros unicornis*
- Sumatran rhino, *Dicerorhinus sumatrensis*
- Javan rhino, *Rhinoceros sondaicus*

African rhinos are the second largest land mammals on earth, and Asian rhinos are a little smaller than their African rhino cousins.

They are the size of a large automobile!

Rhinos can run up to 40 miles per hour!

Rhinos are vegetarian and only eat plants in their diet.

Rhinos have poor eyesight, but a good sense of smell.

A baby rhino can weigh up to 150 pounds when born, the size of an adult human! Rhinos can live up to 40 years in the wild.
