Augusto Azzaroli, paleontologist (Bologna, September 28, 1921), since 1960 was a professor of Palaeontology at the Università di Firenze.

Founder and director of the Museo di Geologia e Paleontologia, internationally reputed as one of the most prominent vertebrate palaeontologist, he is Member of the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei and of the Accademia delle Scienze di Torino, among others.
