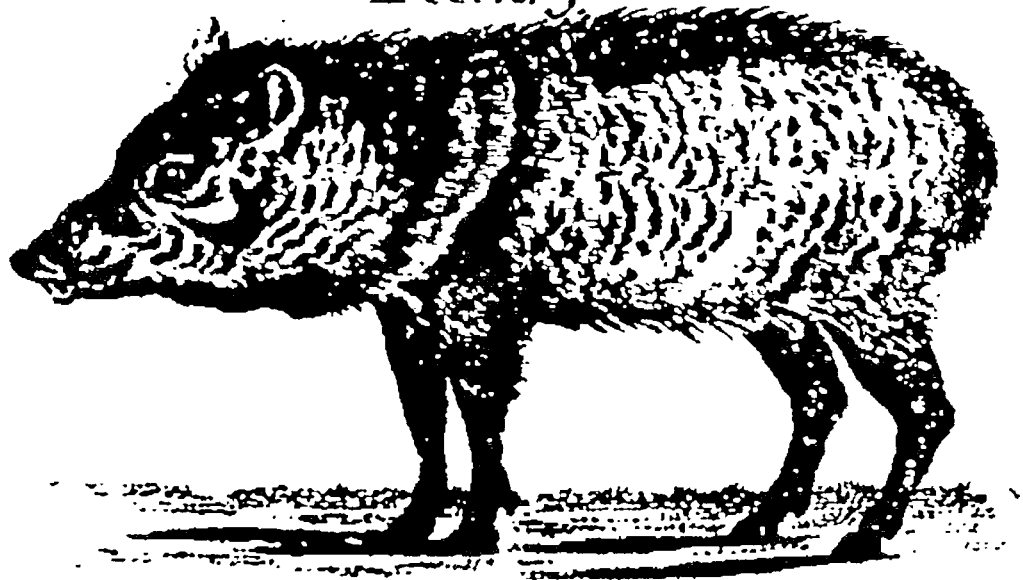
RHINOCEROS.

Next to the elephant, it is the most powerful of animals. The tiger will more willingly attack any other enemy of the forest, than this formidable creature.

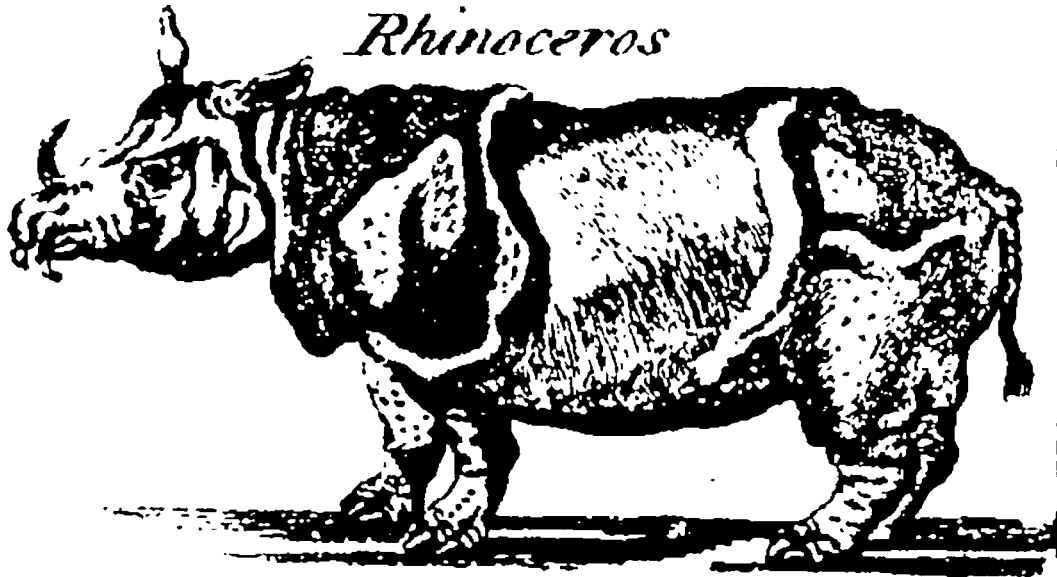
BABYROUESSA, OR INDIAN HOG.
