

# VICEROY'S SHOOTING TRIP.

LOHAPARA, February 15.

On Friday his Excellency the Viceroy and party bagged one tiger. On Saturday Lord Minto, accompanied by the Maharaja of Cooch Behar, started out from camp about 4 a.m., in quest of rhinoceros or buffalo. Though herds of each were seen, his Excellency was unable to obtain a shot at a bull of either species, and so returned to camp without having fired a shot.

At 1 p.m. to-day better fortune favoured the party and one buffalo and one rhinoceros were shot. Two other bull rhinoceros, as well as cows and calves, broke through the line, one elephant being upset by their onslaught but no damage was done. The jungle is very thick and only the admirable arrangement of the Maharaja of Cooch Behar and Mr. Copeland, Forest Officer, enabled the difficulties to be overcome.
