WINGS OF PROTECTION: A NEW ERA FOR PROJECT RHINO!



We are beyond thrilled to share some game-changing news that will take our conservation efforts to new heights – literally! Thanks to the incredible support of the Brady Hunter Foundation, we've secured a brand-new savannah plane for our aerial operations!

This fantastic development means Zululand now boasts not one, but TWO vital aircraft:

- ✈️ A patrol aircraft to keep a watchful eye on our precious reserves
- ✈️ A response aircraft to swiftly respond to any conservation threats

With this enhanced capability, we'll be able to protect our wildlife and reserves even more effectively.

But that's not all! We are also excited to welcome Bertus Nagel as our new Operations Manager in Zululand, overseeing the Project Rhino airwing and K9 unit. Bertus brings invaluable expertise to the team, ensuring our operations run smoothly and efficiently.

In a major milestone for our Midlands region, we have launched the first-ever Midlands Aerial Patrol Wing (MAPWing)! Pilot Ross MacBey will be taking to the skies, providing critical support to our conservation efforts. We're thrilled to have Ross on board!

A huge thank you to the Brady Hunter Foundation for making this possible. Together, we're making a real difference in the fight against wildlife crime and conservation.

ON THE PROWL: LATEST FROM THE K9 UNIT



We are thrilled to share the remarkable achievements of our K9 units! Building on our existing K9 units and services, we are excited to announce the expansion of our K9 capabilities to 5 new member reserves that previously didn't have access to our K9 services. This additional unit has hit the ground running, making a significant bust within just 2 weeks of operations, catching rhino poachers and retrieving 4 rhino horns!

Training for Excellence:

To ensure our K9 handlers and K9s continue to excel, we've scheduled three intense 2-week training sessions for the year with renowned K9 specialist Johan van Straaten. This expert guidance will guarantee our team receives the best training and support possible.

March Milestones:

Here is a snapshot of our K9 unit's impressive performance in March:

- Total Hours Trained: 125
- Foot Patrols: 1785km covered on foot
- Vehicle Patrols: 3950km patrolled by vehicle
- Fence Patrols: 639km of fence lines secured

We're incredibly proud of our K9 team's dedication and hard work. Their efforts are making a tangible impact in the fight against wildlife crime.

EMPOWERING YOUNG SWIMMERS THROUGH THE OCEANS 8 CHARITY SWIM 2025



It is less than 50 days to the Oceans 8 Charity swim, happening on 14 and 15 June at DUC, Point Water Sports Club, Durban.

Swimming has the power to change lives - especially for youth from underserved communities.

That's why we're spreading the word about an inspiring initiative: The Oceans 8 Charity Swim Youth Development Swimmers Program.

In 2024, four young athletes and their coach from Durban's Lamontville Swimming Academy (LSA) experienced their first open water event through Oceans 8. With the support of an anonymous donor and their dedicated coach, these swimmers completed more than just a 1-mile swim - they gained belief in themselves and their potential.

LSA teaches children from township communities how to swim, promoting water safety and offering a positive path forward. Oceans 8 is helping take that mission further.

What's Next?

In 2025, the Oceans 8 team aims to invite 10 young swimmers (5 girls and 5 boys) to participate in the 1 mile leg of the event, but they need help to make it happen.

A donation of R1,700 will support one swimmers Oceans 8 dream and provide them with their entry, costume, cap, medal, event goodie bag, transport and meals!

All donations are eligible for Section 18A tax certificates.
